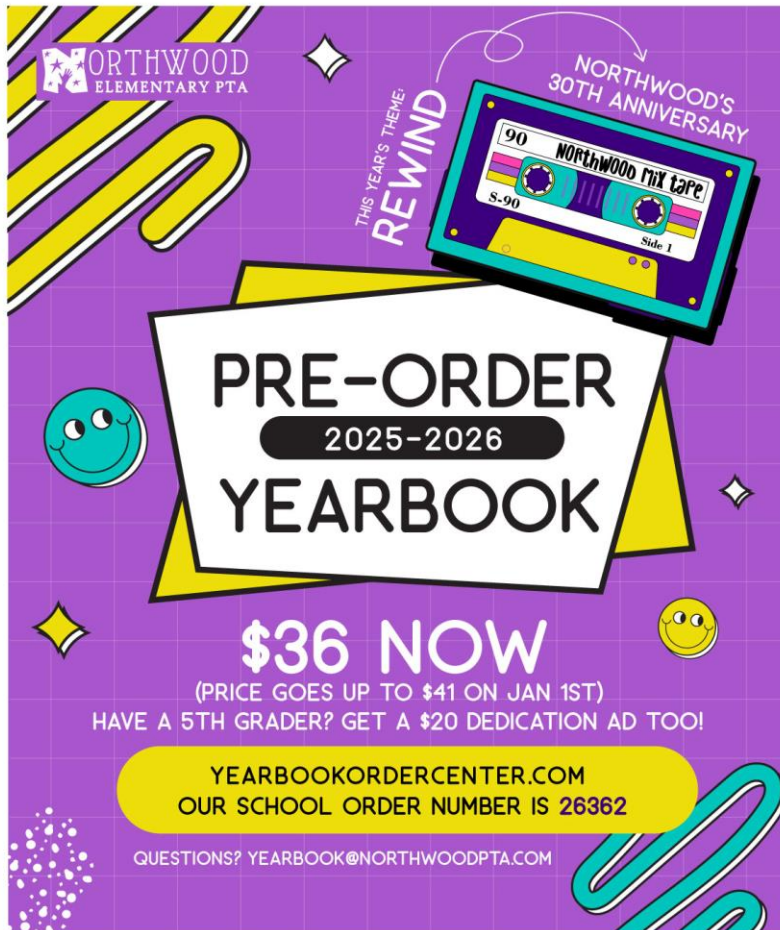

Curriculum Notes: What's Coming Up Next Week?

Math 1: Students will order numbers based on place value and have a unit review in preparation for the Unit 3 test on Thursday.

Math 2: Students will estimate and measure to the nearest inch, foot, and yard.

Reading and Phonics: The question we will explore next week is “How do we measure time?” We will read fantasy, poetry, and non-fiction texts. Students will review retelling stories and identifying the beginning, middle and end of a story. Next week will be a review of previously learned phonics skills.

Writing: Students will respond to a fantasy text by extending the story. They will also use strong verbs in their sentences.

Social Studies: We are jumping back into our historical figures and will be learning about Thomas Jefferson.

Student Success Skills: Students will learn about alternatives to tattling.
