Admission Information

PreK/Petite Section

Dear Guardians,

We are pleased that you have selected International College (IC) as a prospective school for your child for the **2026-2027** academic year at the PreK/Petite Section grade level. Kindly find the important admissions information outlined below.

I. REQUIREMENTS

A. **Age limit:** PreK / Petite Section grade-level applicants must be three years old by **October 15, 2026**.

Grade Level	Cut off Date	Date of Birth
PreK/PS	3 years old by October 15, 2026	Between: October 16, 2022 - October 15, 2023

B. Readiness

All PreK/ Petite Section students must be **toilet-trained** before starting the 2026-2027 school year. Children need to be able to communicate their basic needs, including the need to use the bathroom.

II. ADMISSIONS PROCESS

A. Submission of Application (SA)

The application form is available online on [Eduka](#).

Kindly ensure that the documents listed below are properly uploaded to the online application portal.

1. A passport photo of the applicant
2. A copy of the ID card, passport, and Individual Civil Registry Record (إخراج قيد فردي)
3. A copy of the birth certificate from the hospital where the child was born
4. A copy of the diploma if the parent(s) is/are IC graduate(s)

Admissions online application forms are accessible starting **November 03, 2025**. The deadline for submission of applications is **January 5, 2026**. Applications submitted after this date will be evaluated on a space-available basis. Parents can contact the admissions office if they require assistance.

B. Guardians' Meeting with the Early Childhood Principal and/or the Assistant Principal

Once the initial application review is completed, the Early Childhood administration will arrange an **online** meeting. This session will allow guardians to engage with either the Early Childhood Principal or Assistant Principal, establishing a foundational relationship.

C. Qualified Submitted Applications fee Verification (QSA)

Following the screening phase, applicants who meet the eligibility criteria and have submitted **complete** applications will be identified as Qualified Submitted Applicants (QSA). These candidates will be invited to pay the non-refundable application fee (\$199) in order to proceed to the next step of the admissions process.

Guardians are required to pay the application fee in cash at the **Business Office** located in Thomson Hall, IC Ras Beirut campus. The cashier's working hours are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., except on Wednesdays when the hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 1:45 p.m.

Following payment, guardians should present the official receipt at the **Admissions Office**, located in Thomson Hall, adjacent to the Business Office, to complete verification and proceed to the next phase of the admissions process.

D. Teacher-Child Interview

The Early Childhood administration will communicate the time for the in-person teacher-child interview on **January 10, 2026**.

E. Results

The Admissions Committee will review the applicant's file per the school's established policies. The Admissions Office will announce the committee's decision at the **end of January 2026**, and the results will be emailed to families.

Should you decide not to enroll your child(ren) at International College after acceptance, please notify the Admissions Office and the Early Childhood Office in writing, allowing the vacancy to be offered to other applicants.

KG1/MS (Kindergarten 1/Moyenne Section) and
KG2/GS (Kindergarten 2/Grande Section)

Dear Guardians,

We thank you for your interest in International College (IC) for your child's education in the academic year **2026-2027**. Admissions are contingent upon the availability of vacant spots for the KG1/MS and KG2/GS grade levels.

The admissions process for these grade levels will be conducted during March based on the number of available spots. To ensure a seamless application process, we have outlined some important information regarding admissions below.

I. REQUIREMENTS

A. Age limit:

KG1/MS grade-level applicants must be four years old by **October 15, 2026**.

KG2/GS grade-level applicants must be five years old by **October 15, 2026**.

KG1/MS	4 years old by October 15, 2026	Between: October 15, 2022 - October 16, 2021
KG2/GS	5 years old by October 15, 2026	Between: October 15, 2021 - October 16, 2020

B. Readiness

All KG1/MS (Kindergarten 1/Moyenne Section) and KG2/GS (Kindergarten 2/Grande Section) students must undergo a qualifying interview as part of the admissions process. Applicants must also present records of their previous schooling.

II. ADMISSIONS PROCESS

A. Submission of Application (SA)

The application form is available online on [Eduka](https://www.eduka.com).

Kindly ensure that the documents listed below are properly uploaded to the online application portal.

1. A passport photo of the applicant
2. A copy of the ID card, passport, and Individual Civil Registry Record (إخراج قيد فردي)
3. A copy of the birth certificate from the hospital where the child was born
4. A copy of the diploma if the parent(s) is/are IC graduate(s)
5. A record of previous schooling (report cards from the previous school)

Application forms will be available starting **November 17, 2025**, exclusively for grade levels with potential openings. If the desired grade level or stream does not appear in the application form, it indicates that admissions for that specific class/stream is at full capacity. We encourage you to check back periodically or contact the Admissions Office for updates regarding future availability.
