#### Welcome and Overview

- Samantha Allen welcomed participants, reviewed PAC goals, and summarized the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), now in Year 2 of a 3-year cycle.
- The PAC's role is to study district systems and provide feedback for continuous improvement.

# District Update - Dr. Adam Clark, Superintendent

#### 1. Fall Break and Student Wellness:

- Implemented to support student, parent, and staff mental health after an increase in crisis incidents.
- Collaboration with after-school providers ensured childcare options.
- o Feedback from families is encouraged.

### 2. Career Fair (Oct. 15, 2025 – Concord High):

- Included trade unions, military, public service agencies, and companies such as PG&E.
- o Open to all MDUSD students with district-provided transportation.

### 3. College Fair (Ygnacio Valley High):

- o Hosted university and private college representatives.
- o Promoted both college and career pathways, emphasizing student choice.
- o Upcoming Parent Trade Fair planned for the following week at Concord High.

#### 4. CAASP Test Results:

- o Parents received school performance PDFs comparing multi-year data.
- o District uses test and local assessment data to drive instructional improvements.
- Focus on academic growth and meeting grade-level standards; parents encouraged to engage in data discussions.

# 5. Teacher Union Agreement:

- o Tentative agreement reached prior to fact-finding.
- o District anticipates potential budget reductions and will evaluate which programs to prioritize (e.g., counseling, athletics, IB, dual language, pathways).

# Pupil Services Update – Aurelia Buscemi

#### 1. Centralized Enrollment:

- o Priority order: Residents → Siblings → Staff at site → Attendance agreement
  → Cohorts → Academic programs → Feeder staff → Choice.
- o Requirements:
  - Official birth verification (certificate/passport/baptismal record)
  - Full immunization record and physical exam (per state law)
  - Three proofs of residency

### 2. Transfer Options:

- o Intradistrict transfers (within MDUSD) open until Nov. 10, 2025.
- o **Interdistrict transfers** require MDUSD application and email submission to *transfers@mdusd.org*; notifications issued within 14 days after the start of the school year.

### 3. Attendance Expectations:

- o Mandatory for students ages 6–18 under state law.
- o Excused absences allow makeup work.
- Attendance supports academic progress, emotional well-being, and sense of belonging.
