CUSTODIAL STAFF

Awareness & Involvement (40 points max)

- ☞ Works to create a sustainable environment at the school by promoting eco-friendly practices. These practices include improving energy efficiency, reducing waste, reducing water use, conserving habitat, responsible resource management, proper disposal techniques, reducing stormwater runoff, improving water or air quality, incorporating sustainability practices on the campus, such as assisting with school gardens, mulching, or promoting native/Florida-friendly drought tolerant plants.
- ☞ Demonstrates leadership qualities; provides a good example for others to follow.
- ☞ Works to motivate and/or educate others to use eco-friendly methods.

Current Professional Development (40 points max)

- ☞ Demonstrates personal commitment to environmental principles. Can include attending environmental/green trainings, such as custodial trainings, and those taken outside of work.
- ☞ Promotes others' (community, students, staff) involvement in the school's green programs.
- ☞ Fosters cooperative relationships with colleagues in the green activities at the school.
- ☞ Seeks out trainings, expert advice or other ways to improve knowledge on best management practices for the campus.

Creativity (10 points max)

- ☞ Demonstrates creativity and/or dependability in promoting and/or maintaining the school's green initiatives on campus.
- ☞ Creates new processes to increase green practices on campus.

Attachments (10 points) – documentation and photos (should be high quality images suitable for printing in the program)

- ☞ Provides letter(s) of recommendation(s), other documentation to support application (4pts)
- ☞ Provides at least one high quality image of just the nominee (3 pts)
 Provides at least one high quality image of the nominee in action (environmentally related) **or** a picture that the custodian was involved in its success (a garden, fixed or new facilities upgrades, recycling etc.) with caption explaining picture. (3 pts)

HOW TO APPLY:

There are 2 ways to send in your application (you can use both):

1) Via **ArcGIS Survey123 app** you can access through your phone or your computer. You can take pictures (real-time) and send them towards your application. Make sure that the info you add into the ArcGIS form includes what's in the rubric (previous page).

This form is open to the public which means that anyone can open up an application. However, only BCPS custodial staff will be considered for nominations.

2) Via **Canvas** (<https://browardschools.instructure.com/courses/1990440>). We'll create an application page for your nominee under Opened Applications or Collaborations. Send an email to browardstem@browardschools.com with the following information:

1. Your name and email address (and the names and email addresses of any collaborators) – must be @browardschools.com email address
2. Nominee's name(s) or school name
3. School category (1-5 or all) or Stewardship category (educators, students, non-instructional or custodial staff).

Once we receive your info for the Canvas page, look under the Opened Applications or Collaborations link (left side of Canvas) to see your nominee's name (school or stewardship category). You and your collaborators should be able to access the page(s).

What's the difference between the two ways?

ArcGIS Survey123 app - You can take pictures using your phone or tablet and directly send them to support your application. However, your collaborators have to send in pictures via their own account. The Canvas application has the full requirements.

Canvas application – you can have collaborators working on the same application but you have to upload the pictures. This has the full application template.
