

2024 Grade 7-12 Dropout Report

- The report includes data from **October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2024**. The OSDE verifies these data and issues the report in arrears.
- It is a **snapshot in time** from the 2023-24 school year.
- Students who withdraw for **homeschool are not included**.
- Students who dropout during the month they turn **nineteen are not included** in the dropout count.
- Students listed on an annual dropout report who **re-enroll** in school **after October 1** of that school year **remain on the dropout report**.



2024 Grade 7-12 Dropout Report


Dropout rates are calculated by **dividing** the number of **students identified as a dropout** in the current reporting year by the **number of students that were enrolled** at a school at the beginning of the school year (the October 1 count).

State law (70 O.S. § 35 E) **defines a dropout** as “any **student who is under the age of 19** and has not graduated from high school and is **not attending any public or private school or is otherwise receiving an education** pursuant to law for the full term of the school district in which he/she resides are in session.”




Site and District Support

We are strengthening team capacity at the district and site levels through:

- **Collaboration Across Departments:** Ongoing partnership among Graduation Outcomes, Enrollment, Accreditation, and College and Career Readiness teams to provide clear guidelines for school staff and district offices in locating and re-engaging dropouts.
 - **Site Team Development:** Additional training provided for attendance clerks, attendance deans, counselors, assistant principals, and principals to enhance their ability to address dropout prevention.
 - **Student Tracking Support:** School teams are collaborating with the Family, Youth, and Community Engagement Team in tracking and re-engaging students.
 - **Enrollment Center Collaboration:** Registrars from the Enrollment Center meet with school teams to ensure alignment and support.
 - **Director of Graduation Outcomes:** Direct engagement and collaboration with counselors and school teams to drive effective strategies.
 - **Specialized Schools:** New Vision Academy and North Star continue to focus on graduating overaged and under-credited students through tailored programs.
