Wendy Dunlap from the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) will be hosting a free FAFSA Completion Workshop for senior students and their parents/guardians on **Tuesday, November 18th at 5:30 or 6:00 PM. We are asking families to sign up for either the 5:30 PM or 6:00 PM time slot in order to better assist families with questions.** This workshop will be held in the **Lenape Tech Library**. FAFSA stands for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid and is what needs to be completed in order to determine eligibility for financial aid for post-secondary education. During this event, you will work through completing the FAFSA and Wendy will be available to answer any questions you may have. Our school computers will be available for use or you can bring a personal computer if you prefer.

2026 Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship

The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2026 competition. Male and female students compete separately. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university.

- **Eligibility:** High school senior and U.S. citizen. You **don't** need to be related to a member of the Elks.
- **Judging Criteria:** Academics, leadership, and financial need.
- **Deadline:** **November 12, 2025**
