Mr. Chiera and Mrs. Fassnacht have been hard at work with our 5th grade band and Mr. Bowman has our 4th and 5th grade orchestra doing great work with their violins, violas, cellos, and basses. Band and orchestra are both awesome opportunities for our students to learn to read music, explore new instruments, and practice playing as a group.

Our band had their first concert on Oct. 30 during the Bands in the Round Concert at RHS. The kids were able to take what they have already learned in their individual instrument lessons and perform as an entire band. It was a great experience for them and they sounded amazing, considering they've only been playing their instruments for six weeks!

Mr. Bowman has 66 students in his first year orchestra and has 43 fifth graders in his second year orchestra. The kids are already showing tremendous progress. Spring 2025 OST scores

Parent reports for the spring 2025 Ohio State Tests will not be sent home this year. Parents are able to view scores in Progress Book under the Assessment Scores tab. You will see the name of the test, total score, the placement level, the test date, and the student's grade when test was completed. The total possible score on each OST changes for every subject each year. The only constant is that 700 = proficient. For example, the 5th grade ELA test can be out of 786 points one year and 817 points the next year.
