

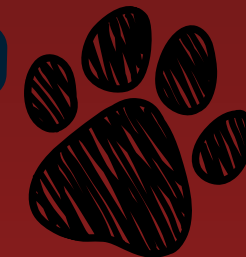

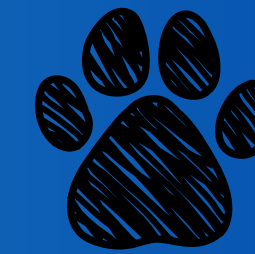

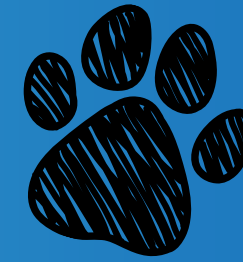

- **WORKFORCE–GAP YEAR/LIFE EXPERIENCE/EXPLORATION– FOR SOME, THIS CAN MAKE THEIR PATH TO SUCCESS THAT MUCH CLEARER.**



TESTING



- **TSI (TEXAS SUCCESS INITIATIVE)**— A TEST THAT ASSISTS TEXAS PUBLIC COLLEGES TO DETERMINE IF STUDENTS ARE READY FOR ENTRY-LEVEL COLLEGE COURSEWORK.
- **SAT (ORIGINALLY THE SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST)**— THE SAT IS A COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAM THAT MEASURES A STUDENT'S SKILLS AND DETERMINES HOW PREPARED THEY ARE FOR COLLEGE, BASED ON WHAT THEY'VE LEARNED IN HIGH SCHOOL.
- **ACT (AMERICAN COLLEGE TESTING)**— THE ACT IS A CURRICULUM-BASED EDUCATION AND CAREER PLANNING TOOL FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS THAT ASSESSES THE MASTERY OF COLLEGE READINESS STANDARDS.
- **ASVAB (ARMED SERVICES VOCATIONAL APTITUDE BATTERY)**— HELPS DETERMINE WHETHER YOU ARE A GOOD FIT TO JOIN THE SERVICE, BUT ALSO WHICH SERVICE BRANCH YOU MIGHT BE BEST FOR.

TSIA2 Testing Dates

What is TSIA2? The Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA2) assesses your academic readiness for college-level courses in **Reading, Math, and Writing**. A college-ready score is required to enroll in **dual credit courses**.

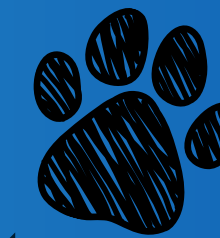

RECOMMENDATION LETTER / TRANSCRIPT REQUEST

RECOMMENDATION LETTER

- **SOME COLLEGES WILL REQUIRE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION DURING THE APPLICATION PROCESS.**
- **A RECOMMENDATION LETTER CAN HELP YOUR APPLICATION STAND OUT, ESPECIALLY WHEN IT HIGHLIGHTS YOUR SKILLS, ACCOMPLISHMENTS, AND POSITIVE ATTITUDE TOWARD EDUCATION.**
- **REQUEST LETTERS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, BUT GIVE YOUR REFERENCES AT LEAST 2-3 WEEKS TO COMPLETE AND SUBMIT YOUR LETTERS.**
- **IT CAN ALSO BE HELPFUL TO PROVIDE YOUR TEACHER WITH A RESUME OR "BRAG SHEET." YOU CAN PICK UP A BRAG SHEET IN THE COUNSELOR'S OFFICE OR THE COLLEGE & CAREER CENTER.**

RECOMMENDATION LETTER GUIDE

TRANSCRIPT REQUEST

- **AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST MUST BE MADE IN PERSON OR IN WRITING. STOP BY THE COUNSELING OFFICE TO MAKE YOUR FORMAL REQUEST.**
- **YOU CAN ALSO ACCESS YOUR UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT IN SKYWARD UNDER "REPORT CARDS/PORTFOLIO".**

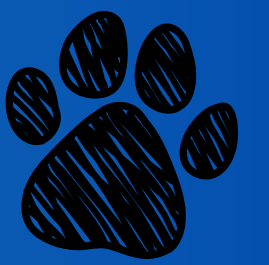
