Assessment

All units are internally assessed and externally moderated, each weighted equally. Assessment is awarded at Pass, Merit, Distinction, and Distinction*

Study Requirements

Tutorials and resources will be available across the portal and on the internet wherever possible to promote independent working. Coursework will be printed or forwarded by e-mail for assessment.

Entry Criteria

A Merit at OCR Cambridge nationals' level 2 if previously studied. As per the Sixth Form general entry criteria, students must achieve the minimum requirements of at least five GCSEs at Grade 4 or above, including both English and Maths.
