

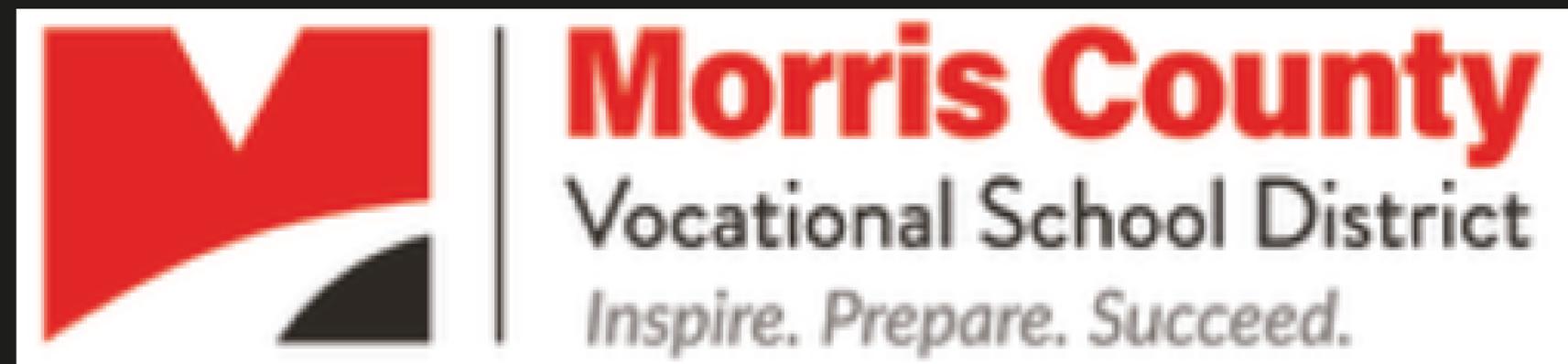

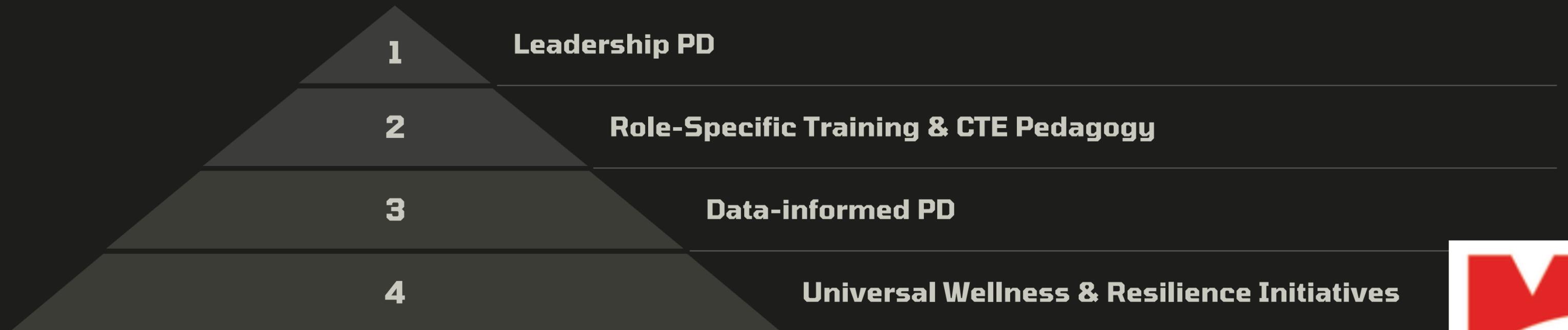


Professional Development Transformation

Current Risks

Critical Gap: One-size-fits-all PD approach creates inequities, especially for share-time and satellite staff with limited access to targeted development opportunities. Sometimes no professional development aligned with job function.

- Limited role-based differentiation
- Limited result driven
- Limited offerings to share-time & satellite staff
- Inexperienced staff underserved (Academy/CTE Teachers)



Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment Alignment

1

Standardize Grading Policies

Continue to develop consistent practices for: placement in honors/AP, and Career Readiness guidelines/policies (WBL) across all academies to ensure fair assessment practices.

2

Link Assessments to Unit Plans

Continue to utilize Atlas platform to connect assessments directly to curriculum units, ensuring coherent instruction-assessment alignment. Data informed and/or standard-based instruction

3

Increase Cross-Department Collaboration

Continue to expand PLC time for interdisciplinary alignment and shared accountability measures tied to NJ-SLA and Perkins standards.



Equity & Access in Advanced Coursework

Current Equity Gaps

- Dual enrollment access varies by academy location
- Some students under prepared for CCM academic rigor
- Honors placement lacks transparent, equitable criteria

Strategic Opportunities

- Formalize CCM articulation agreements with published expectations
- Establish transparent honors/AP/dual enrollment selection criteria (tier 2 support)
- Guarantee equal access to advanced coursework district-wide

Goal: Every student, regardless of academy, has equitable pathways to advanced academic opportunities and college readiness.



Student Support & Accountability Systems



Fall: Early Intervention

Identification of 9th grade students who may need support in Math, ELA, and/or Science, Structured junior family meetings in preparation for 12th grade option(s)

Spring: Portfolio (WBL) Assessment

Consistent accountability systems implemented district-wide. Work-base learning opportunities and internship requirements reviewed.

Winter: Support Expansion

Additional counseling and special education support deployed for share-time students



Critical Need: Share-time students currently receive inconsistent counseling and special education support, creating equity gaps in student services. Reactive approach to need. How is the NOCTI being used to support tiered interventions?

Administrative Structure Redesign



Role Clarification

The district will clarify and streamline administrator roles to eliminate confusion, enhance accountability, and maximize effectiveness across all schools.



Centralized Leadership

Establish centralized leadership structure for satellite and share-time programs with clear reporting lines and accountability measures.
Oversight at satellite locations



Monthly Collaboration

Implement formal monthly leadership meetings to ensure consistent communication and collaborative decision-making.

Current challenges include administrators performing duties outside their expertise and unclear dual enrollment counselor roles.

Overall, the strongest unifying themes were:

- **PD & instructional alignment (teachers need more tailored support and consistency).**
- **Equity of access & expectations (dual enrollment, honors/AP, grading).**
- **Student support structures (counseling, accountability, academic preparedness).**
- **Administrative clarity & collaboration (role confusion, need for effective communication, & oversight).**
- **Sustainability of WBL & Satellite programs.**
- **Facilities/operations constraints (available space, fields, transportation, supervision).**

Academic: By the end of June 2026, in an effort to provide tiered 2 & 3 support that will result in increase student proficiency, 85% of the students taking Algebra I will participate in all three standard-based District benchmarks assessments utilizing LinkIt Form A, B, & C.

02

Fiscal: By the end of June 2026 there will be an identified 100% increase in student enrollment for the share-time programs located at Morris County Career Training Center (CTC)

03

Facilities: Working with NJDOE, by the end of June 2026 infrastructure related to the identification of schools and programs five District schools will be identified at 100% through the New Jersey County District School (CDS) System.

04

Climate & Culture: By the end of June 2026, 75% of the necessary infrastructures and systems for Accurate Attendance, Data Reporting and Safety Concerns will be put in place in all of our facilities including but not limited to satellite locations.
