



NEW TSI Assessment 2.0 Information & Passing Scores

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) assesses your readiness for college-level coursework in English language arts and reading and Mathematics. The results of the assessment, in conjunction with your academic background, goals, and interests, are used by academic advisors to place you in the appropriate courses that match your achievement level in college. The new TSIA2 Exam consist of 2 separate exams: **ELAR & Math**

ELAR (English Language Arts and Reading)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If you score in the range of 945-990 on the multiple-choice Test and a 5 or higher on the Essay, OR- If you score below 945 on the multiple-choice Test, received a diagnostic level of 5 or higher on the Diagnostic Test, and score of 5 or higher on the Essay <p><i>*If you passed the Multiple Choice or the Essay, you do NOT have to retake that part, ONLY the part that you did not pass you must retake. The passing score for the essay portion is a 5 or higher.</i></p>
MATH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- If you score in the range of 950-990 on the Test, OR- If you score below a 950 on the Test but receive a diagnostic level of 6 on the Diagnostic Test.
