- Graduation plan meetings have begun! We meet with all 9-12 students annually to update their progress in:
  - Graduation course completion
  - State assessments and seals
  - Current year academics
- Great Oaks will be presenting to all 10th grade students during FLEX on Thursday, October 20. - CCP students: spring registration deadlines are approaching. You are responsible for meeting with your CCP advisor and registering for classes that will maintain your full-time student status. Communicate these plans with your high school counselor as soon as possible.

## **Parent/Guardian-Teacher Conferences:**

Connecting home and school helps make a great community of learners, which is why Wyoming High School will be hosting **Parent-Teacher Conferences *both* virtually (via Zoom) *OR* in-person on Thursday, November 6th between 3:30 – 6:30 p.m.** We will be using an internet-based booking system from Pick-A-Time to coordinate your meeting times. The booking system will be open between October 22nd – November 3rd, allowing you to use your browser to select which teacher(s) you would like to meet and when.

Conference appointments will be held in 15 minute increments. We ask that everyone is respectful of the 15 minute time limit so that teachers are able to stay on schedule. Thank you for your support in helping our teachers remain punctual when transitioning between conferences. At the secondary level, we also encourage students to attend the conferences because they can prove valuable to the dialogue. Providing students with the opportunity to engage in the process and have their voices heard can be very empowering!

### **Instructions:**

Go to the District's website at [www.wyomingcityschools.org](http://www.wyomingcityschools.org) and select **Quick Links**, select **Parent-Teacher Conferences**, select **Wyoming High School** and begin the sign-up process.

### **How to register:**

1. Enter your email address and push "Login/Create Account".
2. Fill in the required fields and register.
3. For **each** child, **enter their student ID, their security value** (DOB: xx/xx/xxxx), and push "Add".

\*If you've previously registered, all you need to do is enter your email and password. The system will know about your appointments and the children you added to your account.

### **How to schedule a time:**

1. Please select ***either*** in-person or virtual. If you select a virtual conference, you will receive an email with a link to your conference on either November 4th or 5th.
2. Each colored square represents an available meeting time. The legend shows you what teacher corresponds to what color. (**Note:** You will not see all of the teachers, just the set of teachers your children have for class.) **Click on a square to book that time.**
3. After setting when you want the reminder email to be delivered, click "Create Appointment". Repeat until you have a time with each teacher with which you would like to visit.
  - At any time, you can click on "printable schedule" to get a hard copy of your schedule.
  - If you want to make changes to your schedule, you can log in at any time with your email and password.
  - If you have more than one appointment, they will be hidden. Click on the blue circle to the left of your name at the top of the screen to show your appointments. Links will be available to modify the time or cancel the appointment.

If you do not have internet access and/or need assistance, please contact Ms. Corinne Doyle,

In the event you are not able to schedule a conference on November 6th, please feel free to contact the teacher. Every effort will be made to accommodate your request for a conference. Teachers are available during plan periods to meet needs if you are unable to attend on the original conference date.
