Don't settle for "good enough" when the best college for you is out there waiting!

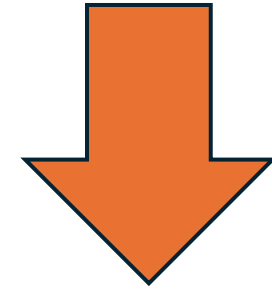




Finding the college that is right for you means understanding the three primary components of “fit.”

The college visit

- Tour campus
- Meet with admission counselor
- Meet with financial aid office
- Meet with professors
- Attend a class
- Attend a campus event
- Talk with students
- Eat lunch on campus
- Pick up a student newspaper
- Meet with extracurricular groups
- Stay overnight in a dorm
- Look for posters of events around campus



Ask questions!

- Why did you choose this college?
- What is the best reason to go to this college?
- What do students do in their free time?
- How do students get experience in their chosen field?
- How do students get help in their classes?
- Is it hard to get into the classes I need for my major?
