UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE INCLUDES

Midriff Shirts

Shirts & blouses that show the belly



Facial Piercings

Excessive Including nose, eyebrows and lips



Distracting Hair

Including unnatural colors, mohawks and spiked styles



Jeans with Holes

If they are frayed above the knee, they must be worn with leggings underneath not to expose the skin



Headwear (Indoors)



Short Shorts

Boys and Girls
No more than 2 inches above the knee



Skirts & Dresses

No more than 2 inches above the knee

Strapless Shirts

(spaghetti strap Shirts)
Including blouses that only partially cover the shoulders



Leggings

Skin-tight trousers, a tighter version of the capris, flared or ankle length. No skin tight or athletic fitting.



Pullover Hoodies

Front-zip Hoodies allowed; unzipped and hood off while indoors



Pajamas & Slippers



Offensive Clothing



San Benito CISD students shall adhere to the following general dress code expectations:

1. Wear appropriate school clothing that adheres to the mode of dress at each campus.
 - A. No Pajamas
2. Practice proper hygiene that promotes a neat, clean, and prepared appearance.
3. Have hair that is clean and groomed with styles that are not extreme or create a disruption.
4. Keep beards and mustaches neatly trimmed.
5. Use proper undergarments at all times.
6. Use proper footwear that does not create a safety hazard or noise-making devices.
 - A. No Slippers
7. Use of knee-length walking shorts is permitted.
8. Use of shorts may be worn in physical education classes, as required.
