Ahfachkee Warriors Athletics Code of Conduct

The Ahfachkee Warriors Athletics believes that good sportsmanship, discipline, and respect are as important as athletic skill. This agreement helps build a positive foundation of behavior and accountability for all elementary student-athletes.

Code of Conduct

As an Ahfachkee Warrior, I agree to:

Behavior Expectations

All student-athletes must demonstrate sportsmanship, respect for teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents always. Attendance at practices, games, and team meetings is mandatory unless excused by a coach or school administrator.

Academic Requirements

Student-athletes must maintain good academic standing and meet eligibility standards as set by the school. Academic performance takes priority over athletic participation.

Attendance

Student-athletes are expected to attend all scheduled classes on days of practices or contests and must not miss more than one-half of any scheduled class to remain eligible, unless the absence is excused by the Athletic Director. In accordance with Florida and Hendry County attendance requirements, consistent class attendance is a condition of participation in school athletics. Maintaining good attendance demonstrates commitment, responsibility, and the Warrior standard of excellence both in the classroom and in competition.

Dress & Appearance

Athletes must present themselves appropriately in both practice and competition. Team-issued apparel should be worn with pride and maintained in good condition.

Social Media Conduct

Athletes are expected to uphold the school's values in all online behavior. Posts, comments, or media that are disrespectful, harmful, or inappropriate will result in disciplinary action.

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Disciplinary Policy

The goal of discipline within the Ahfachkee Warriors Program is education and growth, not punishment. All disciplinary actions are handled with fairness and communication between the coach, parent/guardian, and Athletic Director.

Level	Behavior Example	Consequence
Level 1 – Reminder/Warning	Minor disrespect, inattentive behavior, off task talking, or lateness to practice.	Verbal warning; reflection talk with coach. Parent may be notified.
Level 2 – Written Reflection/Temporary Removal	Repeated Level 1 behaviors, arguing, refusal to participate, or poor sportsmanship.	Removed from activity for the day; completes reflection sheet. Parent notified.
Level 3 – Parent Conference/Behavior Contract	Continued disrespect, unsportsmanlike conduct, or unsafe behavior.	Parent conference with coach and AD; formal Behavior Contract; 1–2 practice suspensions.
Level 4 – Suspension from Team Activities	Failure to follow the Behavior Contract, physical aggression, or defiance of staff.	Suspension from team for up to one week; written notice filed with AD.
Level 5 – Removal from Team	Repeated Level 4 offenses, bullying, fighting, or threats to safety.	Removal from team for season pending AD review; parent meeting required.
