### Open Gym Wednesdays

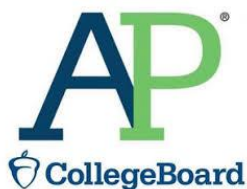

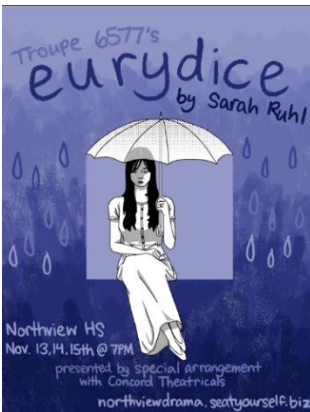


\*Our digital display board is up advertising the upcoming pathways night on the 12<sup>th</sup> of November as well as our 3DE magnet program.
