# Statement of Faith

At **The Master's Academy**, our Statement of Faith reflects the core beliefs we hold as a **Christ-centered school** community. While it does not encompass every detail of our convictions, it expresses foundational truths that guide our mission, our teaching, and our life together.

We affirm that the Holy Scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testaments, are the inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God. Scripture stands as our final authority for truth and practice in every area of life. As God's perfect revelation, His Word speaks with absolute authority concerning reality, morality, and the calling of every believer. Through Scripture we know the living God and are shaped by the "sure foundation" of the teachings of Jesus Christ and His apostles—truths given for the blessing, growth, and direction of His people until Christ returns (Matthew 28:18–20; Acts 2:42; 1 Corinthians 15:1–11).

Because of this conviction, **The Master's Academy** is committed to teaching, upholding, and living out biblical truth in every discipline and activity. We are not free to redefine or depart from Scripture, but joyfully submit to God's Word as our supreme authority. As followers of Christ, we seek to pursue peace with all and honor legitimate authority. However, in matters where human authority conflicts with the clear teaching of Scripture, we obey God rather than man (Acts 4:18–22), striving to do so with grace, humility, and steadfast faith.

As a Christ-centered school rooted in Scripture, we are committed to developing students who love God and live for Him. We encourage you to explore the 11 elements of **The Master's Academy** Statement of Faith, where each core truth reflects our commitment to equipping students to know Christ, follow Him, and stand firm in biblical truth.



# **1 Scripture**

I believe in the verbal, plenary inspiration of both the Old and New Testaments, i.e., that the very words of the original Scriptures are infallible and inerrant, and that they are our final and absolute authority in every area of life and knowledge.

*2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21*

# **2 The Trinity**

I believe in one God, eternally existing in three coequal persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

*John 4:24; Romans 8:14–15*

# **3 Jesus Christ**

I believe that Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and that He is both undiminished Deity and genuine humanity in one person forever.

*Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18–25; John 1:14*

# **4 The Holy Spirit**

I believe that God the Holy Spirit is a personal Being who convicts the world of sin and who regenerates, indwells, empowers, guides, and bestows spiritual gifts on believers, and who seals them eternally for God.

*John 16; Romans 8; Ephesians 1:13–14*

# **5 Humanity & Sin**

I believe that man was created by a direct act of God in His image, not from previously existing life, that all men sinned in Adam (the historical father of the entire human race) and thus incurred both physical and spiritual death; and that all men have inherited a sinful nature.

*Genesis 1; Romans 5; Ephesians 2:1*



## **6** **Salvation & Atonement**

I believe that Jesus Christ died as a substitutionary sacrifice for our sins and that through faith in Him as Lord and Savior, we are declared righteous by God.

*2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 7*

## **7** **Grace Alone**

I believe that salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, totally apart from human merit, and that the experience of regeneration produces a new creature in Christ.

*Ephesians 2:8–9*

## **8** **Resurrection & Priesthood of Christ**

I believe that Jesus Christ rose bodily from the dead and that He ascended in like form into Heaven, where He continually ministers as our Great High Priest and Advocate.

*Luke 24; Hebrews 10; 1 John 2:1*

## **9** **Christ's Return**

I believe in the literal, visible, bodily return of Jesus Christ with His saints to establish His Kingdom.

*Acts 1:9–11; Revelation 19*

## **10** **Final Judgment**

I believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost.

*Revelation 20–21; 1 Corinthians 15*

## **11** **The Great Commission**

I believe that all believers are under the mandate of Jesus Christ to proclaim the Gospel to all the world.

*Matthew 28:18–20*



# SALVATION

The Bible teaches that the foundation to finding one's true purpose and meaning in life is found in a personal relationship with God through His Son, Jesus Christ. Beginning that relationship is an act of faith, believing what the Bible says about God, us, and Jesus Christ. Our Statement of Faith is based on fundamental truths we learn from the Bible about that relationship.

A simple help to guide us in taking this step of faith is the acronym, ABC. Admit, Believe, and Confess.

## **ADMIT** that you are a sinner.

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” Romans 3:23

## **BELIEVE** that Jesus paid for your sins by His death on the cross.

“But God demonstrates His own love for us: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

## **CONFESS** that Jesus is the Son of God, and commit your life to Him.

“That if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.” Romans 10:9
