
CENTENNIAL

Through a federal Magnet Schools Grant, and under the direction of Magnet Schools Director Drew Hirshon, STREAM programming is now in place at Centennial High School-Design and Innovation Academy, Park View School of Discovery and Risley School of Exploration.

STREAM and Project Lead the Way pathways are intentionally aligned to high-demand, future-focused careers, including Engineering and Architecture; Robotics and Automation Technology; Health Sciences and Medical Technology: Cybersecurity and Computer Science; Construction and Skilled Trades; and Technical Theatre, Digital Arts, and Design.

At all three schools, sleek Innovation Zones will serve as the hub of STREAM programming, with the

spaces put in place over the summer months.




MAGNET SCHOOLS GRANT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CONTINUES
