Course Description

This qualification is a Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma, which is the equivalent to one A level.

The course is made up of a series of different sized units, two of which are mandatory.

The mandatory units are:

MUSPRA 387E – Rehearsal Skills & Live Music Performance

MUSPRA 349 – Planning a Career in Music

Students are then encouraged to choose units that supplement their musical tastes, talent, curiosity and skill set. Optional units include:

Lead Performer, Session Musician, Music Improvisation, Improving Instrumental Performance, Composing for Film & Media, Practical Harmony Application, Live Sound Recording, Music Sequencing and Production, Studio Sound Recording, Remixing and Production and many more!

Assessment

MUSPRA 387E – Rehearsal Skills & Live Music Performance is an externally assessed unit.

MUSPRA 349 – Planning a Career in Music and all optional units are internally assessed units.

Entry Criteria

GCSE Grade 5 or above in Music. Performance audition and music theory test will be used as a replacement for GCSE Music if not studied at GCSE.
