## Attendance

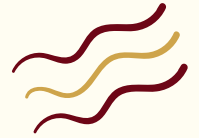
- Attendance will be taken each day

## Science

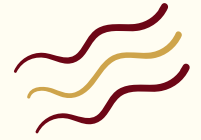

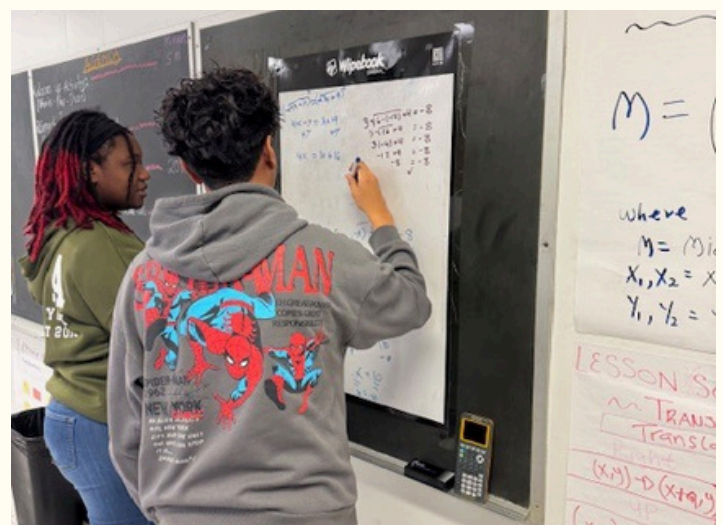
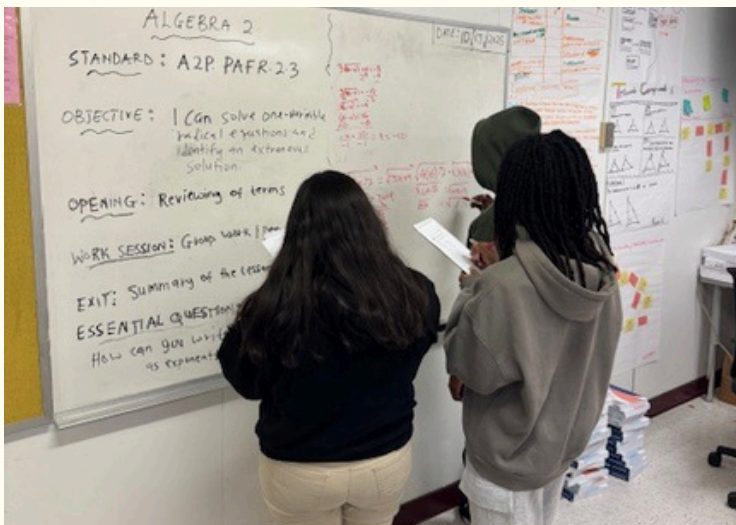
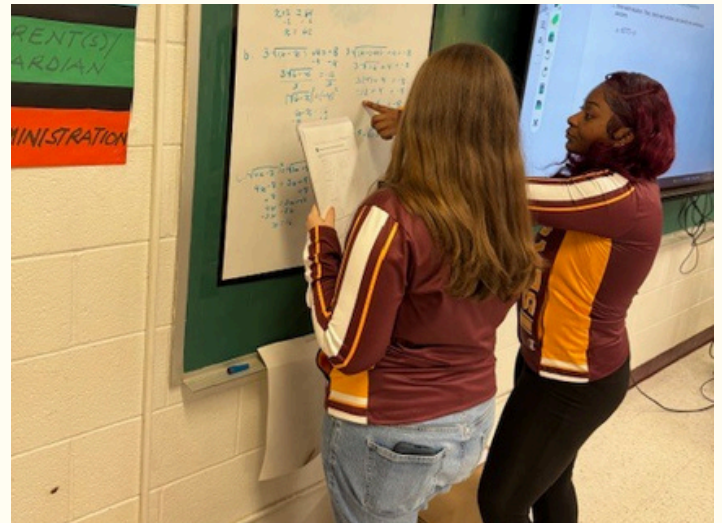
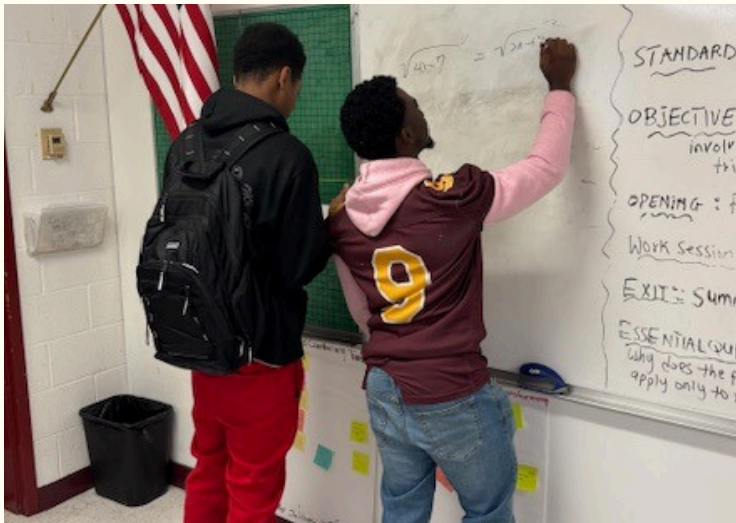
## Social Studies

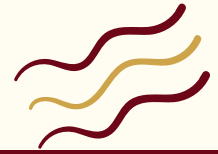


## Math

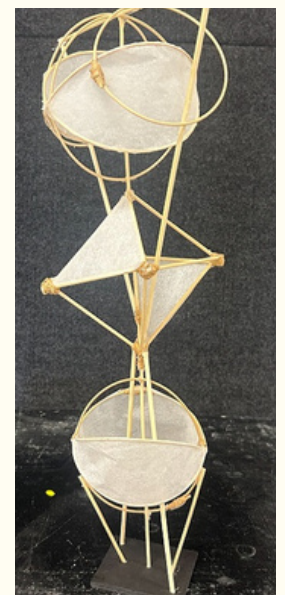
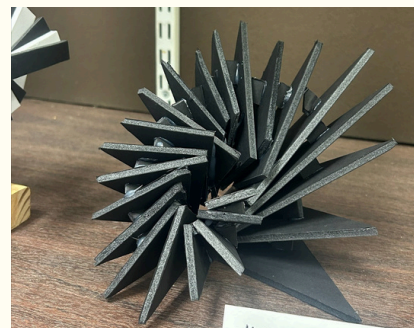


## Fine Arts

The Marion High School Honors Art III - assignments include a posterized painting as well as High Contrast Collage work.

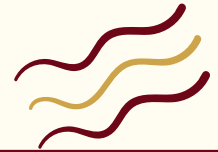


Art II has been working with sculpture and form - assignments include sculpture that illustrates 'movement and rhythm' while other work illustrates a concept for architecture...
