Dear Roslyn Families,

I'm reaching out with a few reminders regarding fall dates for our 2025 District Calendar.

Monday, October 13th, the District will be closed for Columbus Day.

Monday, October 20th, is Superintendent's Conference Day, which means no class for students. Schedules for high school athletic games will be provided by coaches, as per Section VIII Athletics. All other middle school and high school after-school sports and activities are canceled. BOCES will be closed.

Election Day, Tuesday, November 4th, the Roslyn School District will host a districtwide **Full Remote Instructional Day**. This is being done to allow the district a practice day to troubleshoot unforeseen issues, as well as familiarize and reinforce practices, so that if the district needs to go remote due to inclement weather or any other reason, everyone will be comfortable and productive.

Students are expected to adhere to certain protocols during our remote learning day. [Click here to read the Full Remote Instructional Day Rules and Expectations](#). All parents must review this information with their children prior to November 4th.

In the coming days, school principals will communicate additional details specific to their buildings, as well as provide information regarding technical support.

All middle school sports and after-school activities will be canceled on Election Day. At the high school, coaches will provide schedules for practices/games, and club advisors will inform members if their club will be held or canceled for the day.

The Full Remote Instructional Day will operate on a **two-hour delayed opening schedule**. Students will log on from home two-hours later than the normal school day. There will be no BOCES programs for in-person or remote learning on November 4th.
