AP Test registration is due on November 12th! See the following list to determine if an AP test is best for you:

- ✓ You would like to attend an out of state or private college
- ✓ Your current AP class does not offer college in the HS credit

Students must pay for AP exams. The College Board charges the following for exams:

- \$99 per exam
- \$53 per exam for students receiving free or reduced lunch

If a student registers for a test and then decides not to take the exam, they will be charged a \$40 return of exam fee.
