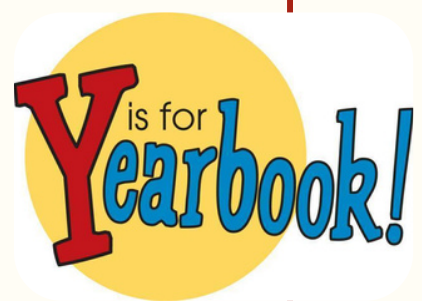

COLD WEATHER ALERT

With the coldest weather months right around the corner, we wanted to remind you of a few important things:

- 1. Students are allowed to enter the building each morning at 7:30 a.m. unless they are eating school breakfast in our cafeteria. Students are not to bring their own breakfast items into the cafeteria during breakfast time. Students that are eating a school-sponsored breakfast are allowed to enter at 7:10 a.m. All other students who are NOT eating breakfast will need to wait to enter the building. Please, make sure they are dressed for the outside elements.**
- 2. Also, our students need to vacate the building each day by 3:00 p.m. unless they are participating in an after school-related event. Our supervision ends at 3:00 p.m. so students will be waiting outside to be picked up after this time.**
- 3. Even in the cold months of December, January, and February, the students will be going outside for recess on most days. When going out for recess, it is another instance when we want our students to be protected against the cold. Students will have the option to remain inside if they want to play card games or sit and talk quietly with their friends.**

We know that by working with you, our students can be outside safely because they are dressed appropriately!
