2026-2027 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATION
PROCESS IS NOW OPEN

In preparation for the upcoming school year, families are now invited to apply for financial assistance. The assistance program is offered to all eligible families. To apply for assistance, please follow the following steps.

1. Go to the school website (stpaulhs.org). Click on “Admissions” and then “Financial Assistance”.
2. There are two documents that we collect from every family applying for assistance.
 - A. CEF TAP form. This is available in English and Spanish and we must have one for every student in the family attending St. Paul. The form must be completely filled out including the second page (income, mortgage/rent, and vehicles).
 - B. The St. Paul form. We only need one form per family because all siblings can be listed on this form.
3. **Complete** Federal Tax Return (not just pages 1 and/or 2). State returns and W-2's are not accepted. Until February 28th, the Federal Tax Returns can be from 2025 or 2024. Assistance applications submitted after February 28th must be submitted with the Federal Tax Returns from 2025.

If your family is eligible for CEF based on the eligibility criteria included on the website, we must have your forms on file no later than December 19, 2025. All of the forms can be scanned and emailed to FinancialAssistance@stpaulhs.org or brought into the office and we will make a copy for your records. We will be processing these over the vacation and mailing all applications to CEF on your behalf by the due date CEF has assigned as January 9, 2026.

We ask that you not bring in the forms and leave them with anyone in another department. Please do not email them to the admissions office or give them to a coach to submit on your behalf. The front office staff can help you or you can email them to the correct email address.

If your family is not eligible for CEF based on the eligibility criteria included on the website, there is available assistance from the school. These applications are due in the office by January 9, 2026 to qualify for the first review window. Late applications for families eligible for CEF will be forwarded to them and the families will be placed on a waitlist. We will continue to accept the applications but they will be processed in subsequent committee reviews. Please email any questions or concerns to Financialassistance@stpaulhs.org.
