Seniors!

We have made it through one of our first major college application deadlines of the year - November 1st. Our School Counselors and Seniors have been hard at work submitting over 1,500 applications to 286 different colleges as of today. At this point, approximately 73% of the Senior class has applied to college and will continue to submit more applications as we go through the winter.

- Please make sure you are giving your Counselors at least two weeks notice of your application deadlines
- Check if any of your colleges require first quarter grades (different than midyear grades) - we will be sharing a Google Form soon to request your first quarter grades be sent to your colleges.

College Admissions Testing

Attention 10th and 11th Graders!

- <u>PSAT scores</u> we administered the PSAT to all 10th and 11th Graders on October 22nd. Scores should be released soon students should monitor their email for a communication from the College Board.
- Practice SAT / ACT through our partnership with Revolution Prep, we are offering a FREE practice ACT on November 15th and SAT on December 6th.

9th Graders!




