# STEP 1 CLASSIFY YOURSELF...

## what type of skier are you?

Determining your skier type is your responsibility!

Your skier type, height, weight, age and ski boot sole length are used by the shop to determine the visual indicator settings of your ski bindings.

Be sure to provide accurate information, as any error may increase your risk of injury. Consult these descriptions to select your classification.

TYPE 1

**"CAUTIOUS SKIER AT LOWER VISUAL SETTINGS"**

- Prefer slow to moderate speeds.
- Prefer gentle to moderate terrain.
- Receive lower than average visual indicator settings. This may increase the risk of inadvertent release.
- Type 1 settings apply to "entry-level skiers uncertain of their classification."

TYPE 2

**"MODERATE SKIER AT AVERAGE VISUAL INDICATOR SETTINGS"**

- Prefer a variety of speeds.
- Prefer varied terrain.
- Type 2 skiers are those who do not receive all the accommodations of Type 1 or Type 3 skier types.

TYPE 3

**"AGGRESSIVE SKIER AT HIGHER VISUAL INDICATOR SETTINGS"**

- Prefer fast speeds.
- Receive higher than average visual indicator settings. This may reduce the likelihood of release in a fall in order to decrease the risk of inadvertent binding release.

TYPE 1

For skiers who desire visual indicator settings lower than average for a Type 1 skier.

TYPE 2+

For skiers who desire visual indicator settings between a Type 2 skier and a Type 3 skier.

## RENTAL AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I accept for use AS IS the equipment listed on this form, and accept full responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession.

I will be responsible for the replacement at full retail value of any equipment rented under this form, but not returned to the shop.

I understand that there are inherent and other risks involved in the sport of skiing for which ski rental equipment is to be used, that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of the sport, AND THAT INJURIES, INCLUDING INJURIES INJURING NECKS, CAN OCCUR REGARDLESS OF THE USE OF A SKIBOOT INCLUDING BINDING SYSTEM, and I freely assume those risks.

I understand that the ski boot binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release, and I therefore do not guarantee for my safety.

I understand that the snowboard/best binding system will NOT ORDINARILY RELEASE during use, nor is it specifically designed to release as the result of force induced during ordinary operation, and is therefore ABSOLUTELY NO GUARANTEE FOR MY SAFETY of any injury that may occur.

I HEREBY RELEASE ELK MOUNTAIN AND ITS OWNERS, AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE AND INJURY TO MYSELF OR TO ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY RESULTING FROM NEGLIGENCE, INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, THE SELECTION, ADJUSTMENT AND USE OF THIS EQUIPMENT OR ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT RENTED TO ME OR WORKED ON BY ELK MOUNTAIN, ACCEPTING MYSELF THE FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY AND ALL SUCH DAMAGES OR INJURY WHICH MAY RESULT.

I understand that if involved in an accident at this ski area I must report it immediately.

I know that I must ski in control at all times and adhere to Skiers Responsibility Code.

I understand that I will be charged a \$10.00 service charge for all late returns. I also understand that I am responsible if any equipment is lost or stolen.

I will retain a copy of my daily rental agreement receipt form. It is necessary when returning my equipment.

Alpine, Nordic and Snowboard skiing, including the use of lifts is a dangerous sport with inherent and other risks. These risks include but are not limited to variations in snow, steepness and terrain, trail side drop-offs, ice and icy conditions, moguls, rocks, trees, and other forms of forest growth or debris (above or below the surface), bare spots, lift towers, utility lines, poles and guy wires, snowmaking equipment and component parts, trail fences and the absence of such fences and other forms of natural or man-made obstacles on and/or off designated trails as well as collisions with equipment, obstacles or other skiers. Trail conditions vary constantly because of weather changes and their use. These are some of the risks of skiing. All of the inherent and other risks of skiing present the risk of serious and/or fatal injury.

IN CONSIDERATION OF USING THIS EQUIPMENT AND ELK'S SKI FACILITIES, I AGREE TO ACCEPT THE RISKS OF SKIING AND AGREE NOT TO SUE ELK MOUNTAIN SKI RESORT, INC. ## RENTALS

If you paid for the lift and rental package, you will go directly to rentals to obtain your equipment. Helmets are not included with your rental package. Rental helmets can be purchased for \$13.00 per visit OR you can prepay an additional \$40.00 for (7) helmet rentals at time of registration. Please make sure you check mark the helmet rental box on the front of your application if you are prepaying. Helmets available for purchase for as low as \$50.00 in our ski shop.

## REFUNDS

No refunds! Prorated next season credits will be issued to those who cannot complete the program due to injury or illness with a valid doctor's note submitted to our main office.

## APPROPRIATE CLOTHING, STORAGE AND LOCKS

When preparing for your visit to Elk Mountain, dress in layers, have waterproof gloves, warm head/face wear, winter coat and waterproof snow pants.

We strongly recommend participants securely store their belongings and lock up equipment. We have lockers available to store items inside the Main Lodge and in our Rental Dept. The lockers range in price per use.

SKIS, POLES AND SNOWBOARDS ARE NOT PERMITTED INSIDE OUR LODGE. Elk Mountain has Ski Key locks available for purchase in our Ski Shop. The Ski Key System tracks are used at many other resorts across the United States, so your lock can be used at other ski resorts. We recommend you lock all of your equipment when not in use! Elk Mountain is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

## WHO CAN JOIN?

Elementary and High school students are encouraged to participate as well as established church and community groups. If your group allows it, we welcome parents and siblings to join the program.

Children under the age of 8 cannot participate in the complimentary group lessons, however private lessons for children under the age of 8 can be purchased in our Ski School. Children under the age of 5 will receive a complimentary lift ticket with a paid participating ADULT. Rentals and lessons are NOT complimentary and sold separately.

## SCHEDULED VISITS

(7) Scheduled visits from 4:00 pm- 9:00 pm on your groups scheduled day. The last week for lessons is the week of February 19, 2026. After that, you may continue to ski or snowboard on your scheduled night until night skiing and snowboarding ends. Your RFID card is valid only for the day of the week and time that you sign up for. If you would like to ski at any other time, you may purchase a lift ticket at [www.elkskier.com](http://www.elkskier.com) or at our ticket windows.

In the event that there are Elk Mountain closures that affect your night, we will add a visit or visits on a different night to accommodate your missed visit(s).

## COST

**\$199 for Lift and Group Lesson** Includes lift ticket and complimentary group lesson for each visit. You must be 8 years or older to participate in our group lessons. **\$269 for Lift, Lesson and Rental** Includes lift ticket. Complimentary group lesson and ski or snowboard rental with boots. Helmets are available for an additional cost of \$13 per visit. \$40 pre-paid for all visits or you may purchase a helmet for as low as \$50 in our Ski Shop.

## PAYMENT

Advisors are responsible for all payments from participants and submit to Elk Mountain by the deadline, December 11, 2025.

## DUE DATE FOR PAYMENT, APPLICATION AND PHOTO

We do NOT accept applications, payments or photos via email.

The DEADLINE to join the program is Thursday December 11, 2025.

Group advisors have the authority to set their own due dates. Please adhere to their set due dates.

Photos for your RFID card may be taken and submitted to Elk Mountain by your advisor or you can visit Elk Mountain to have your photo taken. Please take care of your photo in advance, you can experience a long wait time if you wait until the day of or days leading up to your first scheduled visit. We encourage you to get your photo taken before our ski season begins!

Elk Mountain's (OFF SEASON) office hours are Monday through Friday 9AM - 3PM and Saturdays 9AM - 1PM. Once Elk is open for skiing, our office hours are Sunday through Wednesday 8:30AM - 4:30PM and Thursday through Saturday 8:30AM - 9PM.

## ID CARDS

Participants will receive a pre-programmed RFID card for (7) scheduled visits. The card does not need to be presented at the ticket window. Place the card in your left pocket and proceed to the lift. The RFID card will need to be presented at the Rental Office to receive weekly rentals. Abuse of this card (allowing another person to use the card) will result in permanent loss of skiing privileges. The card cannot be used on any other day except your scheduled day. Please do not hole punch the card, doing so will deactivate the card.

**DON'T FORGET YOUR I.D CARD!** If you forget your card there will be a \$5 fee to issue a ticket for that visit.

## COMPLIMENTARY GROUP LESSONS FOR 8 YEARS AND ABOVE

Our ski instructors are ready to properly teach you how to ski or snow board or help you advance to the next level of difficulty. Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced skiers will greatly benefit from taking a lesson.

ALL participants 8 years and older are eligible for a complimentary 1-hour GROUP LESSON each regular scheduled visit. Lesson participants meet at the base of the Beginners Slope at 5:45pm. Complimentary lessons are not available after your 7th scheduled visit.
