- BOY Assessments
 - K-3 (some 4th) - DIBELS reading foundational skills - 3 times a year - benchmark changes
 - i-Ready - Reading and Math - Adaptive Assessment broken down by domains - 3 times a year - based on growth
- New Building
 - Currently under construction
 - Updated completion date is July
 - Will be in before school starts for the 2026-2027 school year
 - New Furniture
 - Bell Time will remain the same 8:00 - 3:00!
 - Started the Naming Process - will go through November 14th - QR code and google form to get suggestions from community members - 3 names will be submitted to the board, board must vote on final name.
 - Approx. 100 students joining from MGD (3-4 per class)
 - Looking at staffing. Expected enrollment around 800 students. 2 APs and 2 counselors
 - Campus will be walkable. There will be a walk zone down Willow Oak up to Moe's on East. Parents will be able to park and walk also.
 - Community is involved and events will continue at the new school.
 - Pre-K will not be included at the new building.
 - Afterschool clubs will be assessed once we are in the building. Indoor clubs will possibly continue plus Soccer Shots, Little Sticks, etc. Transportation is working on adding routes for Jolie Dance, Tennis, Tom Sykes, etc. 5 days per week has been requested for activities around Latta Campus. No decision has been made yet.
 - Suggestion - Riding bikes once a month on Freedom Parkway
 - The plan is for Carpool to be a double lane, and is much longer than our current carpool lane. Suggestion Reese Road and Haven Drive - will try and work with city for Stop Light.
 - CMS will give schools a police officer to direct traffic if it is on a main road. Our hope is that we will get an officer from CMS.
 - Meeting next Thursday 11/6 to discuss magnet school that is moving into Dilworth's current building.
- New Policy
 - Number of people coming in and out of the building
 - We only have a nurse 50%. Secretaries have to handle all medical needs when nurse is not on campus.
 - Many items are dropped off throughout the day - rackets, lunch boxes, folders, etc...

- To keep our school and Dragons safe, we are trying to minimize the number of people coming in and out of the building.
- Ordered containers for student drop-off and one for teacher drop-off.
- Student drop-off bin will have a QR code for parents/guardians fill out a google form.
- Bin will be emptied 3 times a day - before first lunch, 12:00, and 1:30.
- Parent Lunches will remain for this year, but protocol for next year is currently under discussion.
