As we are getting further into the school year, please review the cell phone policy below:

For the Upper School, when a device is confiscated, the following procedures will be used: • First offense: The device is confiscated, given to division administration, and the student receives after school detention • Second offense: The device is confiscated, given to the division administration, the student receives three after school detentions, and the parent(s) must retrieve the phone. In the Spring semester, a second offense results in a loss of exemptions. • Third offense: The device is confiscated, given to the division administration, the student receives Saturday detention, the student must turn in the phone every day, the parent(s) must retrieve the phone and the parents must meet with the administration.

PSAT Scores Released

Students that took the PSAT on 10/9 should have their scores available now. There are 3 ways to view scores:

- 1) <u>Log in or create</u> a College Board account. If you already have a college board account for AP classes or other assessments, start here. If not, you may want to create an account as this will be used in the future.
- 2) Download the BigFutures mobile app, enter the phone number students listed during exam setup, and receive a code to log in. For this to work, students must have entered their number during the exam setup process.
- 3) Ask the college counselors. Mr. Traylor and Mr. Savoie can access score reports and share them with you if one of the above methods does not work.

Here is a video explaining how to view scores and understand the score report.

AP BILLING

To complete the exam ordering process for students enrolled in AP courses, the College Board's \$99 fee / exam will be added to your October FBCA bill. Please note that if you see increases to your school bill in October, it may simply be the exam fees for AP courses. If your student is not enrolled in any AP courses, you should see no changes.

Students were automatically registered for exams when they joined AP Classroom for their courses. If any student enrolled in an AP course has not joined AP Classroom, they will need to see the college counselors or their AP teacher as soon as possible to get that corrected.
