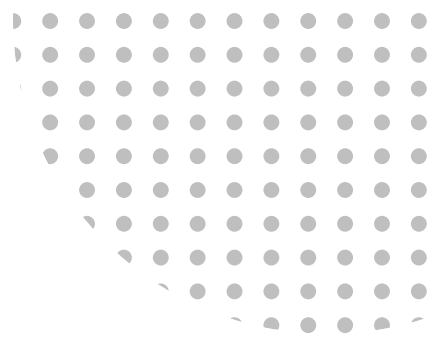

What Kind of Learning?

How do you teach critical thinking?

- Exploring evidence: doing and experiencing
- Curiosity: learning to ask great questions
- Seeking multiple perspectives: Global mindset and intercultural thinking
- Going deep & finding connections: studying subjects with intensity

Deep Knowledge Questions

- Are there situations where “knowing how” is more important than “knowing that”?
- What knowledge might be lost if the whole world shared one common language?
- Why do facts sometimes not change our minds?
- Does what is seen to constitute “good evidence” vary from culture to culture?

How do you test critical thinking?

- Expressing ideas: writing + public speaking
- Problem-solving: tests designed to stretch thinking (not check for memorization)
- Reflection: emphasizing process + product
- Stepping into the role: thinking like... (not learning about)

What Kind of Teaching?

For teachers who love to teach and love to learn, the IB program offers excellent professional development, a network of teachers from around the world, and research-backed pedagogy.

Grade 9 and 10 Foundations

ENGLISH & HUMANITIES – deep critical reading + writing skills

- ▶ Current Affairs + inquiry-based research

SCIENCE – strong foundations:

- ▶ Physics, Chemistry, + Biology = 1 year each
- ▶ Design Tech + Computer Science = semester each + elective

MATH – integrated pathways, where everyone gets to calculus

LANGUAGES – French, Spanish, Chinese, Italian & Arabic

- ▶ Opportunity to take two languages

ARTS – Music, Theater, Stagecraft, Film, + Visual Art
