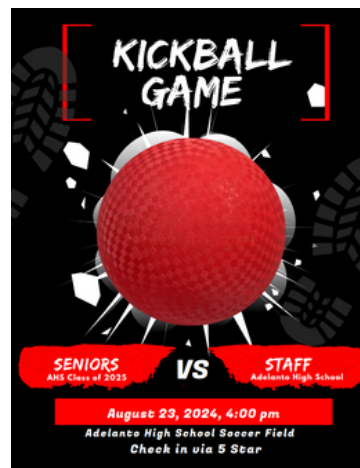
FRESHMAN ICE CREAM SOCIAL

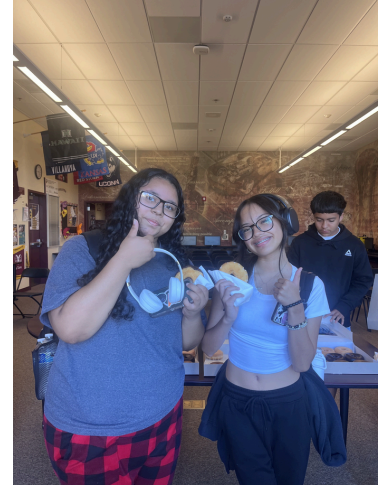
NATIONAL TEDDY BEAR DAY
