Proposition S will be on the November ballot asking for a \$.45 levy increase to recruit and retain quality teachers and staff, expand health care benefits to more employees and enhance safety and security across the district by hiring additional school safety officers. They are presenting in each quadrant in the district in October. Presentations on Proposition S are open to all Rockwood patrons.
