



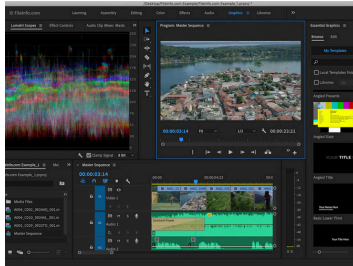
# Media Production:

## Program Overview

The Media Production Pathway at Eureka High School provides students with the academic and technical skills needed to be successful in Film & Video Production. Students will learn camera techniques and the history of film, analyze the work of industry professionals, and develop professional skills in: pre-production, production, and post-production, the fundamentals of video production including the techniques and the aesthetics of shooting, lighting, and editing.
