



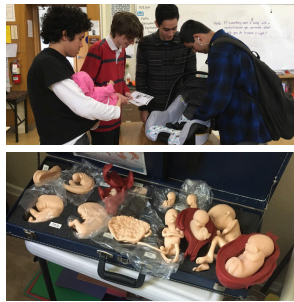
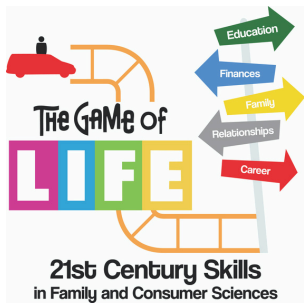
# Education Pathway
