Food insecurity during these challenging times:

If a household is experiencing food insecurity due to the government shutdown or changes to SNAP benefits, please remember that families may qualify for Free or Reduced-Price School Meals.

Families may qualify in several ways:

- If you receive SNAP or TANF, your child automatically qualifies for free meals, but you must apply
- You may also qualify based on household income, check the eligibility chart online, but you must apply
- Applications are quick, confidential, and most are processed within just a few days.

Qustodio: A New Tool for Families to Monitor and Manage Your Child's Online Activity

As part of our ongoing efforts to support digital safety, we're excited to share that Fulton County Schools launched Qustodio on October 20, a free app that helps parents monitor and manage their child's online activity. This tool gives families insight into how students use both district-issued and personal devices.

- For district-issued devices:
 - Parents can see how much time their child spends online, which apps are being used, and what searches are conducted during the school day.
 - Families can also set time limits and restrictions outside of normal school hours to encourage healthy screen time habits.
- For student personal devices (optional):
 - o Parents can choose to install Qustodio on personal devices to monitor usage and set limits at home.
 - Fulton County Schools does not have any visibility or access to data from student or parent/guardian personal devices — that information is visible only to the parent or guardian who installs the app.
