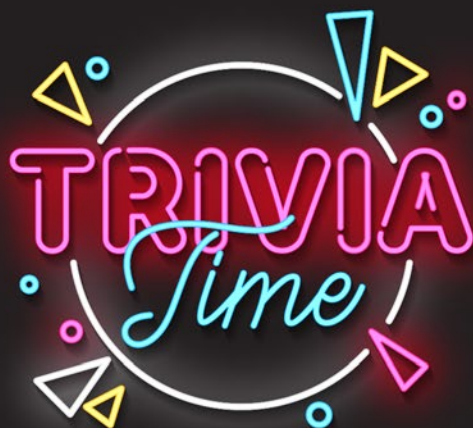

# TRACTOR SAFETY EVENT HELD AT GENESEE VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL

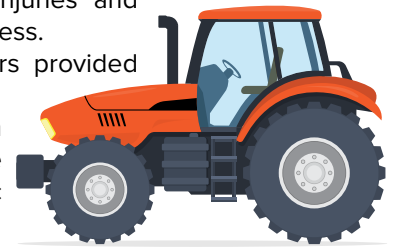


Genesee Valley Central School hosted a hands-on tractor safety and emergency preparedness event on Saturday, September 20. Students from the GVCSD FFA and Junior Firefighters programs, along with volunteer firefighters from Scio, Belmont, and Angelica, explored real-world farm hazards, learned safety protocols, and practiced emergency response skills.

Jim Carrabba, an Agricultural Safety Specialist with the New York Center for Agricultural Medicine and Health (NYCAMH), and Erik Merrell, a Safety Educator and local Paramedic, led the morning session. They guided participants through

parts of the Rural Firefighters Delivering Agricultural Safety & Health (RF-DASH) training, a program designed to equip rural first responders with agricultural health and safety knowledge to prevent farm injuries and improve emergency preparedness.

In the afternoon, two tractors provided by Bainbridge Farm in Almond were used to demonstrate farm equipment hazards, evaluate tractor safety, and review basic first aid practices.

This summer Genesee Valley FFA members were busy attending fairs across WNY.

### ALLEGANY COUNTY FAIR

Derick Grantier took 1st place and Mason Fanton took 2nd place in the Safe Tractor Operation Contest. All 6 GV FFA members placed in the top 10 for Livestock Judging: CayLeigh Shipman 10th, Chilaleah Ormsby 9th, Addison Middaugh 7th, Rylee Ormsby 6th, Mason Fanton 5th, and Sarah Dorrett 4th. The team of Sarah, Mason, Rylee, and Addison took 1st place overall.

The team of Mason Fanton, Sarah Dorrett, Addison Middaugh, and Chilaleah Ormsby took 3rd overall in Dairy Judging and 2nd in Allegany County. The team of Derick Grantier, Mason Fanton, Addison Middaugh, and Liz Grantier took 1st place in Horse Judging with Derick and Mason tying for 1st place and Addison and Liz tying for 6th place. In Tree ID Mason Fanton took 2nd place and in the Livestock Skill-athon Addison took 5th place.

### GENESEE COUNTY FAIR

Mason Fanton took 6th place overall and Derick Grantier placed 2nd in the NYS Safe Tractor Operation CDE.

### NYS FAIR

To conclude the summer season, GVCSD FFA members prepared for the NYS Fair by practicing Livestock Judging and Agronomy at the Cattaraugus County Fair and Small Engine Repair at the Wyoming County Fair. The team of Mason Fanton, CayLeigh Shipman, Sarah Dorrett, and Chilaleah Ormsby represented Genesee Valley at the NYS Agronomy Contest. Rowan Vossler and Sarah Dorrett represented GV in the NYS Horse Evaluation contest while the team of Mason Fanton and Stanley LaForge represented GV in the NYS Small Gas Engine Troubleshooting contest. Stanley LaForge came in 6th place in Small Gas Engine Troubleshooting and Mason Fanton placed 9th individually in Ag Electrification and 3rd individually in Diesel Engine Troubleshooting. Together, Mason and Stanley placed 2nd in NYS for Diesel Engine Troubleshooting.

**Shawn Grusendorf – Angelica Central School, Class of 1993**

A three-sport athlete, Shawn excelled in soccer, basketball, and baseball. As a senior, helped lead his soccer team to a division title while being named County MVP and Outstanding Male Senior Athlete.

**Kristen Hunter – Belmont Central School, Class of 1990**

Kristen was a four-year varsity athlete in soccer, basketball, and softball. She won three Section V soccer championships, was named county Co-MVP, and earned All-Star recognition in basketball and softball.

**Cynthia Humphrey – Genesee Valley Central School, Class of 2011**

The Allegany County Department of Health has grant funding to help address lead-based paint hazards in privately-owned homes and rental units that were built before 1978; with priorities set for homes with children under the age of six and pregnant women due to the long-lasting effects that Lead poisoning can have on them. Remediation work may include painting, enclosure, removal, and replacement of windows, doors, moldings and other surfaces or components that contain lead hazards.

The deadline to apply for the free home repairs is December 1st, 2025.

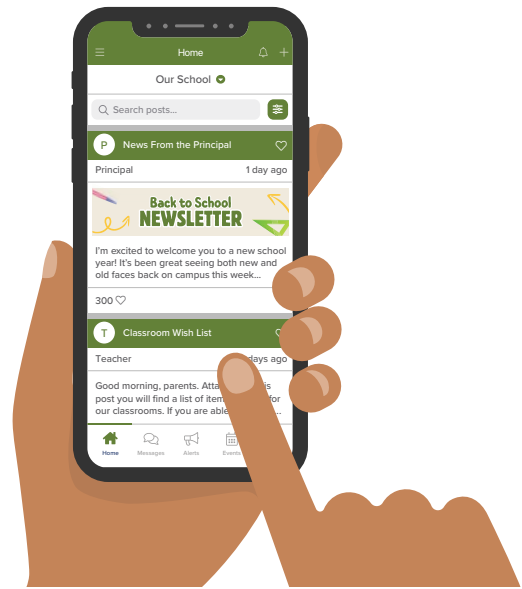
