
## GIVING TREE



### **Perspectiva Salesiana:**

Hoy la Iglesia celebra el aniversario de la dedicatoria de la Catedral de Roma por parte del Papa Silvestre I, en Noviembre 9, 324 AD. A pesar de todo el tiempo desde que esto sucedió, la verdad es que los seres humanos han estado construyendo una cosa y otra desde el principio de los tiempos: la torre de Babel; el arca de Noe; las pirámides; el coliseo; la gran muralla China; la torre Eiffel; la estatua de la libertad; el World Trade Center... ||


