

Superintendent's PIE Meeting

Superintendent Crozier opened the meeting at 10:01 a.m. and welcomed all attendees present via Zoom.

Updates included:

- Superintendent Crozier recognized staff and students for their hard work after receiving a commendation for MCAS Scores. Sudbury is one of 63 districts that surpassed pre-pandemic performance levels.
- Parent / Teacher conferences begin in November. They will be held on the following early release Wednesday's: November 5, November 12 and November 19th.
- The district received approval from the MSBA to execute a funding agreement for the Haynes and Nixon roofs. The district will receive reimbursement from the state for 41% of eligible expenses.
 - There is a special Town Meeting scheduled for December 1st to vote on the appropriation for the roof projects.
 - There is a special Town Election scheduled for December 16th to vote on the approval of those funds. If approved, construction on the school roofs is targeted for the summer of 2026.
- The Tri-District Calendar Subcommittee (Lincoln, LSRHS and SPS) has been meeting since the summer to review religious and cultural observances with a goal to work toward calendar alignment among the districts.

- What types of incident reports involving students are available to residents.
