- Cal-GETC may not be appropriate for all transfer majors. It is highly recommended that students meet with a counselor and/or consult with individual campuses prior to selecting courses.
- Courses used to fulfill General Education may double count with courses used to fulfill a major requirement.
- Courses on this list are approved for the academic year 2025-2026, which is valid beginning Fall 2025 through Summer 2026.
- Students wishing to use a course to meet a CAL-GETC general education requirement must ensure that it is approved for the academic year in which it is taken.

- Each CSU/UC campus will have additional graduation requirements outside the lower division CAL-GETC
- A General Education (GE) Certification is an official document from the College of the Sequoias that certifies a student completing lower division general education breadth.
- Certification is not automatic students must request certification. Students may request certification after acceptance to a CSU/UC.
  - o Official transcripts from all other accredited institutions attended must be on file and will be reviewed for inclusion in the certification process.
  - o A minimum of 34 semester units is required for a complete certification.
  - All official transcripts including college, high school, AP, and IB test scores are required.
- Confirm with a COS Counselor if you meet transfer admission eligibility.
