**V. Presentation: Financial Forecast: Ronda Johnson, Treasurer**

Ronda Johnson, District Treasurer, shared the highlights of the Financial Forecast. Expenditures are outpacing revenue with forecasted expenditure growth at 3% annually and forecasted revenue growth at 2.5%. The end result is declining cash balance with the forecast continuing to point to the need for additional revenue in FY28. Mrs. Johnson reviewed material revenue sources: property tax, income tax and state funding. She also reviewed material expenditures: salary and benefits, purchased services and material and supplies. Finally, she re-iterated that this forecast assumes current law and that there are numerous legislative efforts currently being introduced in the Ohio legislature that, if passed, would limit revenue collection.

**Presentation: WCS District 2024-2025 ODEW Report Card – Tim Weber, Superintendent**

For the progress component, progress was reviewed by grade, subject and building with trend data also shared. The early literacy component breakdown was reviewed by measure. Gap closing, graduation and CCWMR component details were also shared. Individual building report cards and similar district data was also reviewed.
