BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING NOVEMBER 5, 2025

Approval of contracts with school districts and other partners for programs and services:

Approval of contracts with Cheltenham Township School District, Chester Charter Scholars Academy, Chester Community Charter School, Lower Merion School District, Norristown Area School District, Pennsylvania Cyber Charter School, the Pennsylvania Leadership Charter School, and Wissahickon School District for DCIU to provide special education and related services to students from September 2, 2025 to June 2026.

Approval of a contract with Penn-Delco School District for DCIU to provide threat assessment consultation from November 6, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

Approval of a contract with Vision Academy Charter School for DCIU to provide hearing and audiology services from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

Approval of a contract with Vision Academy Charter School of Excellence for DCIU to provide speech and language services from November 6, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

Approval of a contract with Vybe Urgent Care to provide medical services to DCIU partner schools and districts from November 6, 2025 to June 30, 2026.
