


I remember going into the five-and-ten

Oh, Georgie! Why'd you have to kiss the world and make us cry?










# The First Day of School






Christmas as we celebrated it is really for children.


Read the previous paragraphs again, come on now, go back and read them, then you decide, WHAT IS IT REALLY ALL ABOUT?

Do not blindly follow any leader to hell.


Remember, the lesser of two evils is still evil, look for a third choice.

Do not be afraid to stand up for what is right, even it is considered outdated, for right does not change.




