


Packers Crush Carrington 73-0

West Fargo went to the air for 17 yards and six touchdowns in the Packers' easy 73-0 victory over injury-riddled Carrington on Friday night at West Fargo.


Quarterback Bill Maxwell led the Packers to a commanding 41-0 lead in the first half. He threw for 177 yards and six touchdowns. Running back Rick Becker had a 37-yard touchdown pass in the second half. The win was the fifth for the Packers and set up their final game of the season.

The contest was nothing short of disappointing for Carrington coach Pete Kostecky, who went into the game without the services of seven starters. Included on the Cardinal injury list is their leading scorer, halfback Dean Rathe, who has 47 points. Also on the sidelines were the first and second-team quarterbacks.

Welk stayed with his reserves and tried to run up the score. He said after the game, "We aren't 73 points better than them when they were the first and second-team quarterbacks. The Cardinal offense stalled so consistently that Kostecky
