

I really enjoy my time here. I get to know new people, have new experiences, and new ideas.

The language is not too difficult, once I got used to it. I enjoy the weather, especially after all I heard in the fall about snowstorms and temperatures of thirty degrees below zero. 



The 1980 edition of Packer football turned out to be one of the most successful seasons in the history of the school. Many individual and team records were set during the course of the season.

At the beginning of the year, the Packers started off to what appeared to another dismal year. The team, which was predicted to finish near the top of the Eastern Dakota Conference standings, compiled an unexpected 1-4 record in the first half of the season. The low point of the season came in Jamestown. The Pack won every statistical category except one, and that was the final score. The lowly Bluejays stunned the Packer corps 21-20.

Homecoming provided the scene for the team to finally live up to its advance billing. West Fargo ripped the Fargo North Spartans 24-13 for the first time in the history of the school. The Packers controlled every facet of the game to easily handle the Northsiders.

That game ultimately turned out to be the one that turned around the season for the Pack. In the following weeks, the Packers beat Grand Forks Central and Wahpeton to set up the final contest of the regular season

with the Fargo South Bruins. A win would get the Packers into the playoffs.

West Fargo fought from behind twice in the game to nudge South 14-13 in a blizzard. South scored at the beginning of the final 12 minutes, but West Fargo battled back, with Kurt Zabel scoring both a touchdown and the extra point to give West Fargo the win.

In the first round of the playoffs, the Packers faced North Star champ Valley City. West Fargo raced to a 27-0 halftime lead, and then cruised in the second half to win 27-7. The win was costly, though, for West Fargo lost tailback Kurt Zabel with a broken arm.

The next weekend the Packers were eliminated from the playoffs by eventual State champion Minot.

It was a most successful season from two vantage points: a winning record and four all Eastern Dakota Conference selections and two honorable mentions.







With the new arena at the fairgrounds, the Packer outlook for hockey is good.





