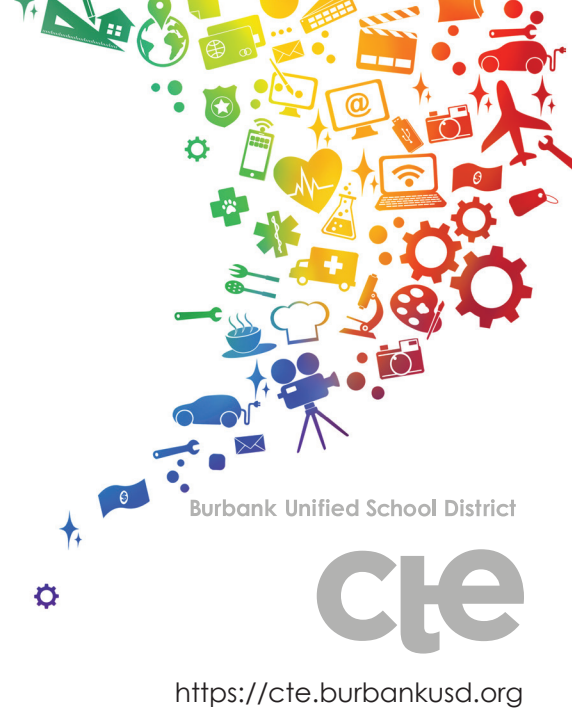

## Important Information:

- No enrollment during winter break, resumes January 5, 2026.
- Schedule subject to changes, courses subject to cancellation by the college if minimum enrollment not met.
- Courses are for elective credit only, **exception:** LAVC's Cinema 107 fulfills either 10 Fine Art credits for high school OR elective credits.
- **ENROLLMENT, DROP and WITHDRAWL** procedures are the student's responsibility.
- Students **MUST** be enrolled prior to first class, have access to Canvas, attend the first class, and regularly be active on Canvas to not be dropped by the professor. **Exception:** Students who are not enrolled by the first class **MUST** email the professor for permission to join the class while completing their enrollment.
- Students can be enrolled in a max of 40 credits per semester.
- Students must have a 2.0 (overall 9-12th grade) GPA to participate in dual enrollment.
- Dual Enrollment grades **are not weighted** like a high school AP course.

**Real Estate 001 and 003 will not be offered through dual enrollment. Students can take for college credit only.**
