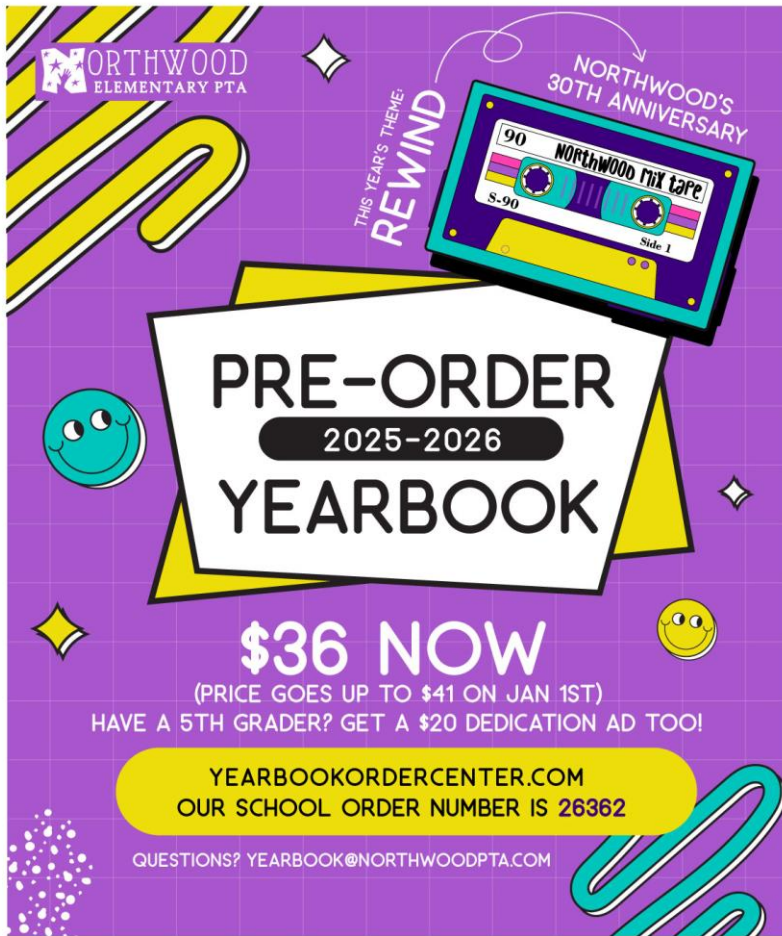

Curriculum Notes: What's Coming Up Next Week?

Math 1: Students will be counting by 2s. Students will also add and subtract within 10 using a variety of strategies.

Math 2: Students will measure in inches from a point on a ruler other than zero and compare the length of 2 or more objects.

Reading and Phonics: The question we will explore next week is "How do plants change as they grow?" The students will also begin learning about digraphs ch and sh.

Writing: Students will be responding to questions based on our essential question "How do plants change as they grow?"

Science/Social Studies: We will continue to learn about our American Historical Figure Thomas Jefferson.

Student Success Skills: We will learn about families and support.
