

VVHS PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICE POLICY

CELL PHONES/HEADPHONES/EARBUDS/SMARTWATCH

The student use of personal communication devices, such as cell phones, tablets, watches, or other similar electronic devices are not allowed at all district school campuses during the instructional day. As long as use is not disruptive, students may use these devices during their scheduled lunch period, during passing periods, and while on district buses. During instructional time in the classrooms, personal communication devices must be turned off, out of sight, and not in use. Students who violate this policy will be disciplined as provided for in the Clark County School District's Behavior Guidelines for Secondary Students. For Virgin Valley High School students, all communication devices must be turned off during the instructional period and put away, not in sight.

Cell Phone Procedures:

- Students must turn off and place their cell phone/earbuds/headphones/smart watches in one of the designated locations upon entering class:
 - Clothing pocket
 - Purse / Backpack
 - School provided storage at their desk, a signal blocking pouch, or cell phone caddy
- Students who violate this policy will be subject to the progressive discipline system outlined below:

	Progressive Discipline
1st / 2nd Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Warning Issued. ● Parent Contact after 2nd offense. Teacher generated email, stating the # of offense that has occurred. ● Minor Behavior Incident for Disregard of Rules/ Regulations entered in Infinite Campus Teacher Log by the teacher, stating the # of offense.
3rd / 4th Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Warning Issued. ● Parent Contact after 3rd and 4th. Phone contact or voice message AND email with description of incident, teacher generated contact, cc Mrs. Rem and Mrs. Aleta Ruth. ● Minor Behavior Incident for Disregard of Rules/ Regulations entered in Infinite Campus Teacher Log by the teacher.
5th or More Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral to office for INSUBORDINATION. ● Student Placed in In-House Suspension and/or Accountability Project assigned. ● Continual violations of Cell Phone Policy WILL result in progressive discipline, student must drop off their phone at the discipline office as they arrive to school and pick it up after school is released for the day, for the remainder of the quarter.
Cell Phone Major	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If at any time, a student refuses to comply with the Cell Phone Policy, a referral for INSUBORDINATION will be entered and progressive discipline will be issued. ● Suspension With Instruction or STARON
