This fall, the District revamped its elementary progress reports to now accurately reflect each student's individualized educational journey throughout elementary school!

As we get ready to debut the new progress reports at Family Conferences later this month, this week's focus is what the assessment letters mean.

Instead of percentages or traditional letter grades, student performance and progress are now evaluated with letters: M, C, I, or N/A:

- **M:** Meets Standards
- **C:** Consistent Progress
- **I:** Inconsistent Progress
- **N/A:** Not assessed This Trimester

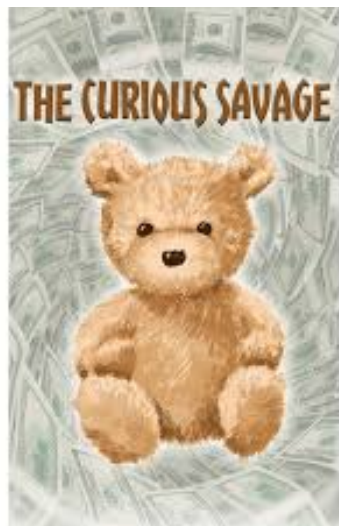

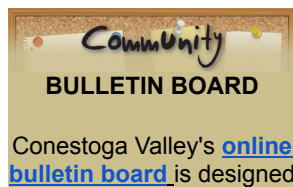
