## What is the Cambridge AICE program?

- Cambridge is an accelerated academic program that helps students reach their academic goals and teaches them how to be confident, responsible, reflective, innovative, and engaged global citizens.

## Why Choose AICE?

- The Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) is an advanced academic pre-university curriculum for students who are working towards International Advanced (A) and Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level qualifications.
- The Cambridge courses are among the highest level, most rigorous courses available to students in Clayton County Public Schools and recognized internationally in over 160 countries.
- Students have the option of taking AICE courses and their subsequent exams in order to earn college credits.
- Enrollment in Cambridge courses will benefit students in the college application process.
- Cambridge courses are on a 5.0 GPA scale, like Advanced Placement courses.
- A Cambridge education provides opportunities for our students to look past themselves and into their neighbors' world by looking at issues from the local, national, and international perspective.
- The ability to see an issue from another perspective will help our students be kinder and give them problem solving and critical thinking skills that will give them a competitive edge in school and in the job market.
- Cambridge is currently recognized by over 700 colleges and universities throughout the United States, including 20 and counting in the state of Georgia!

Students are required to complete at least seven (7) AICE level courses and pass examinations from at least three subject groupings, and the core in order to earn the AICE diploma:

<sup>2</sup> Classical Studies can only be taken during the 10<sup>th</sup> grade year if you're on the AICE pathway as the exam will fall outside of the 25-month window for AICE diploma completion requirements.
