Important Reminders:

- Eastern Suffolk BOCES facilitates the intake and scoring of tests for districts/schools that selected *Optimum Solutions Corp (OSC World)* as their scoring vendor/Lead Scoring Entity when ordering tests from the state.
- OSC will score your Paper-Based Tests (PBT) **only if** your school is also registered with OSC for Computer-Based Test (CBT) scoring.
- Districts should anticipate and register for the scoring of **potential PBT test counts** that may be required for accommodations and special circumstances. *Districts will only be billed for actual tests scored.*
 - ELL students **responding to Math or Science constructed-response questions in a language other than English must use PBT**. This includes students taking Alternate Language Tests or using oral translations for low-incidence languages, unless students are responding *fully* in English.
 - If you have students testing in a grade level and subject, **you must register for some PBT scoring — even if you do not anticipate any PBT needs at this time**. This will act as a placeholder on your contract for students who *may* require PBT due to changes in accommodations or other special circumstances. If you don't anticipate any students requiring a PBT, we recommend registering for **at least 2% PBT** as a safeguard.
 - Science CBTs will continue to be scored by the state's vendor (NWEA). However, **schools using our services must register for the full-service scoring of some Science PBTs as well.**
