The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction released the latest report cards for school districts across the state. As part of the state’s accountability system, these report cards celebrate our schools’ successes as well as highlight opportunities for improvement. ## Overview

As a district, we received a score of 77.0 which is categorized as “Exceeds Expectations”. It’s important to note this data reflects previous school years, including the 2024-25 school year. While it is just now being released to our families and the public, our school district has had access to parts of it since the beginning of this school year to review the data, reflect, and begin work towards continued success.

## Highlights

- Our overall district score improved from 71.5 (“Exceeds Expectations”) to 77.0 (“Exceeds Expectations”)
- Our overall achievement was the same or higher than 78.2% of districts in the state
- Our overall growth was the same or higher than 87.1% of districts in the state
- Our overall on-track to graduation was the same or higher than 75.0% of districts in the state
